This Cookie Notice explains how Norcera uses cookies and similar technologies on our website.

This Cookie Notice should be read together with our Privacy Notice and Website Terms of Use.

1. What cookies are

Cookies are small text files that may be stored on your device when you visit a website.

Cookies can help a website work properly, remember preferences, support security, understand how visitors use the website, or support campaign measurement.

We may also use similar technologies, such as pixels, tags, scripts, local storage, analytics tools, and security tools. In this Cookie Notice, we refer to all of these as “cookies” unless the context requires otherwise.

2. Why we use cookies

We may use cookies and similar technologies to:

- support the basic operation of the website;
- remember your cookie choices;
- help protect forms from spam, abuse, automated activity, and misuse;
- support website security and reliability;
- understand how visitors use the website;
- review website performance, content, and user experience;
- measure campaign performance where relevant;
- support marketing activity where you have given consent or where the law allows it.

We do not use cookies to sell your personal information.

3. Cookie categories we use

3.1 Essential cookies

Essential cookies support the website's basic operation, security, and reliability.

These may be used to:

- load and display the website correctly;
- manage basic website functions;
- remember your cookie choices;
- support website security;
- help protect forms from spam and abuse;
- detect misuse or suspicious activity.

Essential cookies cannot usually be switched off through our cookie banner because the website may not work properly without them.

You can block cookies through your browser settings, but this may affect how the website functions.

Examples of essential or security-related tools may include website hosting tools, cookie preference tools, Cloudflare Turnstile or similar anti-spam tools, and other security technologies.

3.2 Analytics cookies

Analytics cookies help us understand how visitors use the website.

These may help us understand:

- how many people visit the website;
- which pages are viewed;
- how visitors move through the website;
- which pages perform well;
- where visitors came from;
- whether the website is working properly across devices and browsers.

Where implemented, we may use analytics tools such as Google Analytics or similar services.

Analytics cookies are not essential for the website to work. Where consent is required, analytics cookies should remain inactive unless you accept analytics cookies through the cookie banner or another lawful basis applies.

3.3 Marketing cookies

Marketing cookies help measure campaign performance and may support relevant marketing activity.

These may help us understand whether visitors came from a campaign, advert, social platform, or other marketing source.

Where implemented, we may use LinkedIn tracking tools, such as the LinkedIn Insight Tag, or similar tools for campaign measurement and marketing analytics.

Marketing cookies are not essential for the website to work. Where consent is required, marketing cookies should remain inactive unless you accept marketing cookies through the cookie banner or another lawful basis applies.

4. Cookies and tools we may use

The exact cookies and tools used on the website may change from time to time depending on the website configuration and tools we use.

The table below explains the main types of tools we use or may use.

Cookie preference tool	Essential	To remember your cookie choices.	Active where needed
Cloudflare Turnstile or similar security tools	Essential	To help protect forms from spam, abuse, automated activity, and security risks.	Active where used
Google Analytics or similar analytics tools	Analytics	To review website traffic, performance, and visitor behaviour.	Off until accepted where required
LinkedIn Insight Tag or similar marketing tools	Marketing	To measure campaign performance and support marketing analytics.	Off until accepted where required

Some tools may set more than one cookie or use similar technologies. The exact names, durations, and technical details of cookies may be managed through the relevant tool provider or your cookie preference settings.

5. Cookie consent

When you visit our website, you may be shown a cookie banner.

The banner may allow you to:

-
- accept all cookies;
 - reject non-essential cookies;
 - manage your cookie preferences.

By default:

- essential cookies may be active because they are needed for the website to work properly and support security;
- analytics cookies should remain inactive until accepted, where consent is required;
- marketing cookies should remain inactive until accepted, where consent is required.

You can change your cookie preferences at any time through the cookie settings option on the website, where available.

If you clear your browser cookies, use a different browser, or use a different device, you may need to set your cookie preferences again.

6. Essential security and anti-spam tools

We may use security and anti-spam tools to help protect the website and its forms.

These tools may process technical information such as:

- IP address;
- browser and device information;
- interaction patterns;
- security signals;
- date and time of access;
- form submission behaviour.

This helps us reduce spam, malicious traffic, automated abuse, security threats, and misuse.

Where a security or anti-spam tool is necessary to support the operation and protection of the website, it may be treated as essential. Where a tool is used for analytics or marketing purposes, it will be treated according to the relevant cookie category.

7. Analytics tools

Where implemented, we may use analytics tools such as Google Analytics or similar services to understand how visitors use the website and to review the website experience.

Analytics tools may collect information such as:

- pages visited;
- time spent on pages;
- device and browser information;
- approximate location;
- referral source;
- interactions with the website.

Analytics tools should only load after you accept analytics cookies, where consent is required, unless the website is configured in a way that does not require consent under applicable law.

8. Marketing and campaign measurement tools

Where implemented, we may use marketing or campaign measurement tools, such as LinkedIn tracking tools or similar technologies.

These tools may help us understand campaign performance and whether visitors interacted with our website after seeing or clicking on marketing content.

Marketing tools should only load after you accept marketing cookies, where consent is required, unless the website is configured in a way that does not require consent under applicable law.

9. Managing cookies in your browser

You can manage or block cookies through your browser settings.

Most browsers allow you to:

- view cookies;
- delete cookies;
- block cookies;
- block third-party cookies;
- set cookie preferences for specific websites.

If you block or delete cookies, some parts of the website may not work properly.

10. Third-party cookies

Some cookies may be placed by third-party service providers that help us operate, secure, analyse, or market the website.

These providers may process information according to their own terms, privacy notices, and cookie notices.

We do not control all third-party cookies after they are placed by a provider. You should review the privacy and cookie information provided by the relevant provider if you want more detail about how they process information.

We may update this Cookie Notice from time to time.

If we make material changes to the way we use cookies, we may update the cookie banner or ask you to confirm your cookie preferences again.
